Florida Summer Lawn Tips

- 1. **Aerate:** Before summer, aerate your lawn to help water, oxygen, and nutrients reach your roots easier.
- 2. **Fertilize:** Fertilizing your lawn can help it grow and develop in a healthier environment, and produce grass that can withstand the summer heat.
- 3. **Control Weeds & Pests:** If you find weeds, try to remove them as quickly as possible. Pull up the entire root structure to prevent them from growing back.
- 4. **Mow Regularly:** Avoid cutting more than one-third of the height of your grass blades to prevent stress, weeds, pests, and diseases from taking hold.
- 5. Water: Water your lawn daily. Make sure it's not more than a quarter-inch of water at one time. More than this will cause too much moisture and could lead to fungus growth or stagnant puddles.

Remember that any changes that are visible from the street



or neighboring lots

must be approved in writing BEFORE MAKING THE IMPROVEMENT. You can submit your request by visiting our website at www.ElimServices.com and click on "ARB Form". The Committee will meet to review your request at a noticed meeting.
